







KiwiBird stitch ~ by Angie Spong.





This Kiwi Bird Stitch have been designed especially for your PFAFF creative vision, 2100 series, or 7570/7550 machine.

To transfer the stitch from the computer to PFAFF sewing machine ~


Send To: Creative Vision machine (.spx format)

1. Connect USB Stick or machine cable to computer.
2. Machine - touch Selection Menu 
3. Touch Files & Folders  Touch USB icon  External Device.
4. Select computer drive or USB stick and then select KiwiBird.spx.
5. Touch Duplicate  icon. Touch machine memories Personal Files  icon.
6. Touch Paste  to load the KiwiBird.spx file to the machine.


Send To: 2100 series machine (.9mm format) via File Assistant

1. Open VIP, 3D or 4D Embroidery System and open File Assistant.
2. Click the  icon on the right hand side of the screen.
3. Select the required KiwiBird.9mm file.
4. Click the  icon to send file to the Machine – Memory ST-ART folder.
At the Machine ~ Main Menu, touch Personal Menu and Stitch Creator Stitches and touch the stitch icon for the KiwiBird Stitch.

Send To: 7570 or 7550 machine P-Memory (.pcd format) via PCD_win

1. Open PFAFF PC-Designer software.
2. FILE/Open...
3. Select Drive, Folder and then File Name KiwiBird.pcd and OK.
Note: that the Mode in the Status Bar has changed to 9mm.
4. To send the stitch to the sewing machine, click  button, or MACHINE/Send P-Memory... F3.
5. Select an empty P-Memory and OK.
At the Machine (7570 or 7550) to select a stitch ~ press the M-P button, press key 1 (P-Memory) and press the key under the stitch icon for the KiwiBird Stitch.

Send To: 7570 machine (.9mm format) via VIP or 3D Stitch Artist

1. Open VIP, 3D Embroidery System.
2. Open VIP, 3D Stitch Artist - Design Size check 9mm, Next and Cancel.
3. FILE/Open select the required KiwiBird.9mm stitch and Open.
4. SEND menu, then select Send to 7570 P-Memory or . At the Machine ~ see above.
