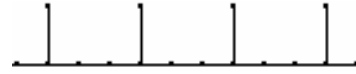


Stitches for 2mm, 3mm, 4mm or 6mm Continuous String Beads ~ by Angie Spong

For use with the PFAFF **Beading Foot 2-3mm, 4mm and 6mm** ~



These Bead Stitches have been designed especially for stitching string beads to the edge of the fabric with your PFAFF creative vision machine and the micro, 4mm or 6mm Beading foot.

How to stitch string beads onto the (folded) edge of the fabric

1. Snap on beading foot - micro (2-3mm) 4mm or 6mm to match the size of your string beads.
2. Thread your machine with invisible thread in the needle (you may need to lower the needle tension) and regular thread to match the fabric in the bobbin.
3. Select the 4mm or 6mm Bead St from stitch category 6, Sewing Techniques.
6mm string beads – use CV stitch 6.2.2 (width 6, length 7.5)
4mm string beads – use CV stitch 6.2.1 (width 4, length 5.5)
3mm string beads – use CV stitch 6.2.1 (width 3, length 4.5)
2mm string beads – use CV stitch 6.2.1 (width 2, length 3.5)
4. Place the string beads in the groove under the foot.
5. Place the (folded) edge of the fabric to the left of the beads.
6. Lower the pressure foot and turn the hand wheel to make enough stitches to secure the beads. The straight stitches run next to the beads (just a mm in from the edge of the fabric), with the stitch across going in-between the beads. Adjust stitch length if necessary.
7. Stitch slowly and DO NOT use the thread snips!
