



PFAFF 2140, 2144 and 2170 Sewing Sequence Exercise by Angie Spong



This is a simple example to show the step-by-step instructions used in the tutorial.







Main Menu, touch Sewing Sequence.



1. Touch  then Selection by Number, touch 172  and .

2. Touch  then Selection by Number, touch 160  and .



3. Touch  then Selection by Number, touch 172 .


Touch  to mirror the stitch and .

4. Touch  then Selection by Number, touch 160 .

Touch  to mirror the stitch and .

Touch  to view the stitch combination.

5. Touch  and then Save As. Touch  3 times to delete NEW.


Type in BOWTULIP and touch  to confirm the name BOWTULIP.SSQ.

Stitch out the combination as a 9mm stitch ~ foot N° 2 and embroidery thread.

Note: To open an existing .SSQ file

Main Menu, Sewing Sequence,

Touch  and Open (sewing machine SEQUENCE directory window opens),

Touch the file name *.SSQ to select and then touch .
